VARIABLE NAME	DESCRIPTION
<b>id</b>	Numerical identifier for each publication. Matches variable <i>id</i> in all other datasets 3 digits, first digit indicating survey wave
<b>pop_id</b>	ID in the population of papers table exported from EbscoHost
<b>authors</b>	Authors of publication [Last name] et al.
<b>year</b>	Year of publication
<b>title</b>	Title of publication
<b>controller</b>	Controller of data is named 0 = no 1 = yes
<b>controller_contact</b>	Contact details of the controller are provided 0 = no 1 = yes
<b>officer</b>	Data protection officer is named 0 = no 1 = yes
<b>officer_contact</b>	Contact details of the data protection officer are provided 0 = no 1 = yes
<b>legal_basis</b>	The legal basis under data protection law on which personal data is being processed is stated (e. g. consent, vital interests of the data subject, public interest, legitimate interest. A list of the applicable legal bases can be found in Articles 6(1) and 9(2) GDPR) 0 = no 1 = yes
<b>legit_interest</b>	If the legal basis is stated as legitimate interests under 6(1)(f) GDPR, it is communicated which legitimate interests these are 0 = no 1 = yes

<b>purp_study</b>	<p>The purpose of data processing is defined as exclusively for the study</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>
<b>purp_other_res</b>	<p>The purpose of data processing is defined as for other research outside the study</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>
<b>purp_other_nonres</b>	<p>The purpose of data processing is defined as for other non-research outside the study</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>
<b>detail</b>	<p>Information about the specific details of the processes and aims of the study is provided</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>
<b>publication</b>	<p>Information about publication of personal data following the study is provided, if relevant (e. g. publication of raw data; cases in which information about publication are not relevant include no publication of personal data, anonymization of personal data)</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>
<b>recip_within</b>	<p>Categories of recipients within the study protocol are specified</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>

<b>transfer_risk</b>	<p>If no adequacy decision, information on the risks of transfers to a third country is provided</p> <p>0 = no 1 = yes</p>
<b>storage</b>	<p>The period of data storage in months, if provided</p> <p>-99 = missing</p>

<b>storage_notes</b>	<p>Additional relevant information about data storage, if relevant</p>
