


# The Boom of Biopsychology and Neuropsychology



## Percentage of English-language literature in the main disciplines of psychology for 2000 - 2004 (PSYINDEX)

The following charts show the development of biopsychological literature from the German-speaking countries in the databases PsycINFO and PSYINDEX. The number of English-language publications, which are essential for international visibility, is increasing in both databases. Also, the clearly above-average percentages of English-language literature suggest a high degree of internationalization within the German-speaking community.



The percentage of biopsychological literature from the German-speaking countries documented in PsycINFO seems solid in European comparison. But when population size is taken into account, the contributions from the German-speaking countries are less impressive. However, the increase during the last ten years is still notable.
