Elektronisches Supplement zu Bittermann, Greiner & Fischer: "Unterscheiden sich die Forschungsinteressen von Frauen und Männern in der Psychologie?"

Im Folgenden sind die jeweils fünf wahrscheinlichsten Begriffe alle Themen sowie die jeweiligen Prävalenzdifferenzen D und Frauenanteile aufgelistet. Unreliable Themen wurden ausgeschlossen. Tabelle 1 ist nach Thema, Tabelle 2 nach Prävalenzdifferenz (absteigend) und Tabelle 3 nach Frauenanteil (absteigend) sortiert.

Die Frauenanteile an den Themen können nicht unmittelbar aus dem Topic Model abgeleitet werden. Dazu muss erst festgelegt werden, wann ein Dokument zu einem Thema gezählt werden kann. Wir haben dies wie folgt operationalisiert: Der Frauenanteil wurde anhand der Anzahl derjenigen Dissertationen bestimmt, in denen das jeweilige Thema das insgesamt Dominierende ist (d. h., der Inhalt der Dissertation lässt sich zu mindestens 50 % diesem Thema zuordnen und zu höchstens 50 % anderen Themen¹). Wenn also etwa von 100 Dissertationen 40 eine Dokument-Thema-Wahrscheinlichkeit von mindestens 50 % aufweisen, dann werden diese 40 Dissertationen als zu diesem Thema zugehörig gezählt. Anschließend wird der Frauenanteil an diesen 40 Dissertationen ausgezählt. Zwar geht durch diesen Cut-Off Information verloren, für illustrative Zwecke ist der Frauenanteil an einem Thema allerdings intuitiver erfassbar als Prävalenzdifferenzen. Abweichungen der Ränge zwischen Prävalenzdifferenzen und Frauenanteil ergeben sich dadurch, dass in die Berechnung von Letzterem weniger Information einfließt.
