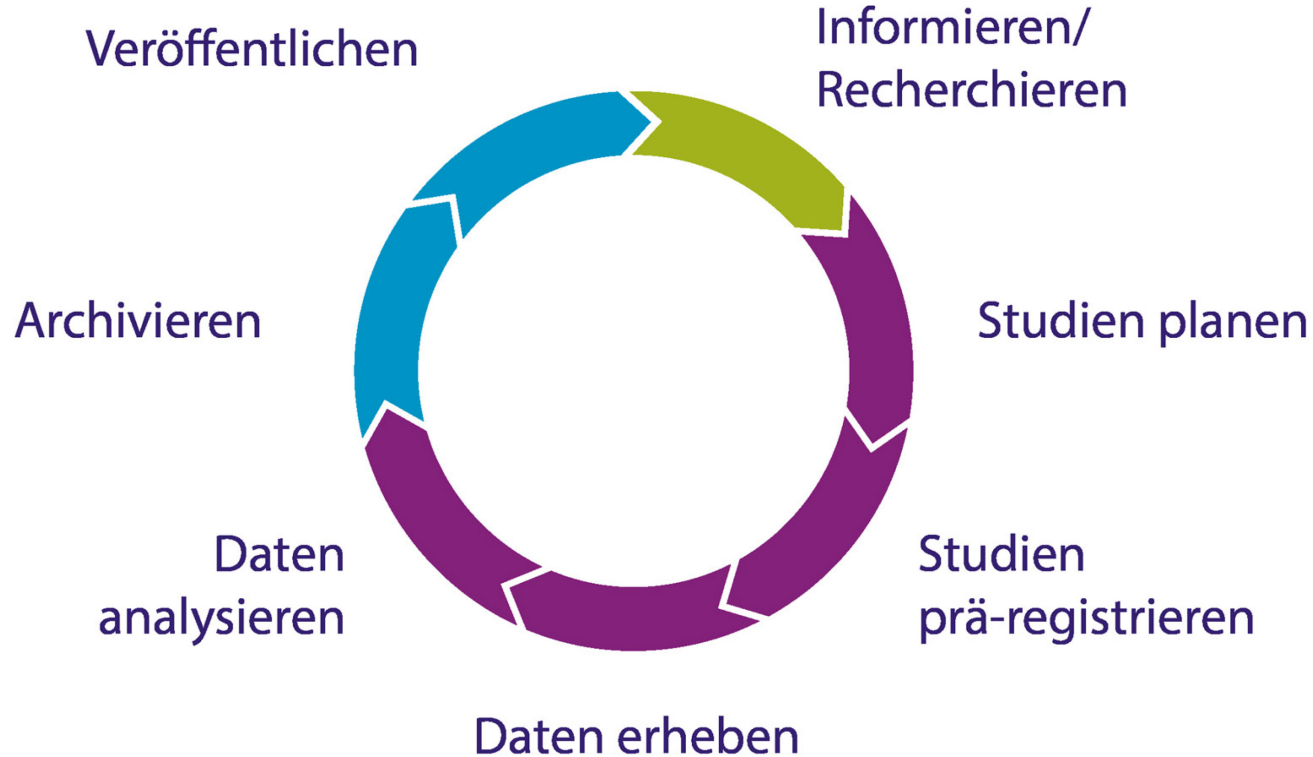

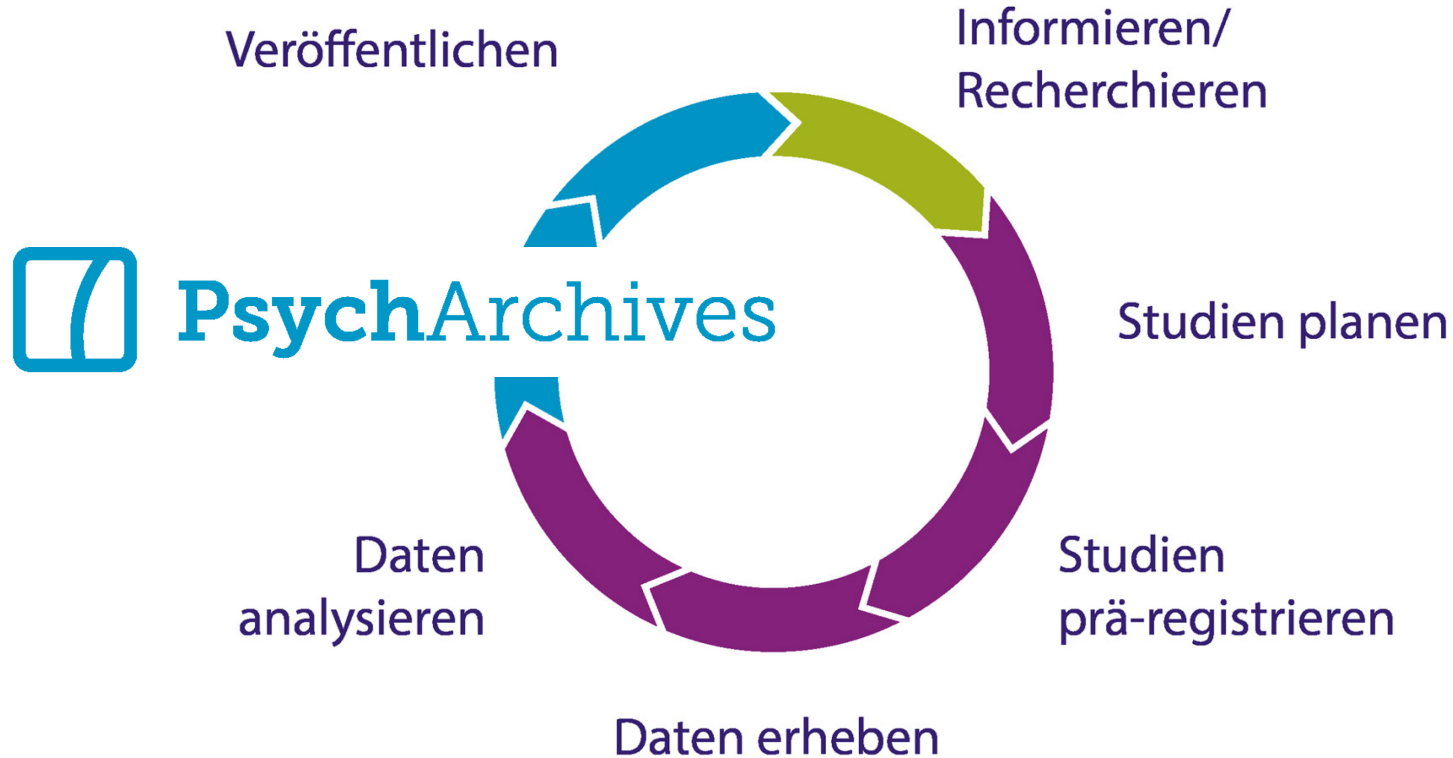

PsychArchives in a nutshell

- Shared Digital Research Objects (DRO)
 - research outputs from the entire cycle of psychological research are welcome.
- Citable and discoverable
 - uploads are assigned a Digital Object Identifier (DOI) to make them easily and uniquely citable.
- Open licensing
 - fostering re-use and open science.
- Safe
 - your research output is stored safely for the future at a sustainable, publicly funded infrastructure.

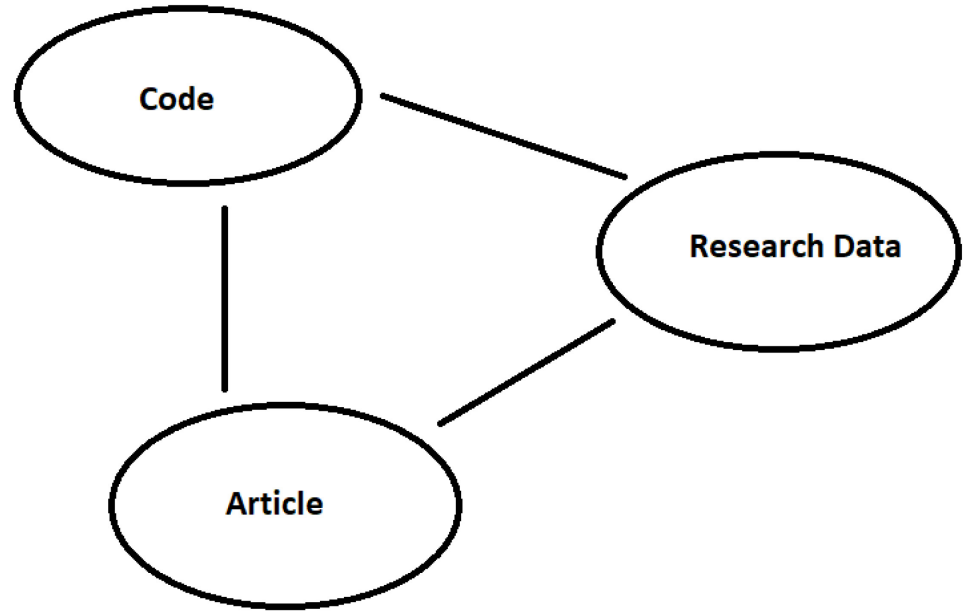

Article	... journal articles in their final published version (publisher version) or accepted manuscript (author version) form
Book	... monographs, edited volumes or conference proceedings
Book Part	... book parts, e.g. book chapters or sections
Code	... source code of software programs, software scripts, parameters needed for software execution
Conference Object	... conference-related publications, such as presentation slides, conference programs and abstract collections
Course Material	... material for teaching and learning
Image	... still images
Moving Image	... videos and animations
Other	... any material not fitting into another category
Preprint	... scholarly manuscripts which have not been subject to peer-review or other common quality assurance procedures
Preregistration	... immutable, time-stamped records of research plans
Report	... institutional or project reports
Research Data	... research data including codebook, data management plans
Review	... reviews of scientific publications or material
Sound	... audio recordings
Supplements	... material related to a manuscript, such as: analyses, tables, figures, maps, appendices, surveys, vote of an ethics board
Test	... psychological tests and measurements, questionnaires, standardized assessment instruments meeting essential test-theory
Thesis (Bachelor)	... theses to earn a bachelor's degree or equivalent
Thesis (Doctoral)	... theses to earn a doctoral degree or equivalent
Thesis (Habilitation)	... theses to earn a habilitation degree or equivalent
Thesis (Master)	... theses to earn a master's degree or equivalent

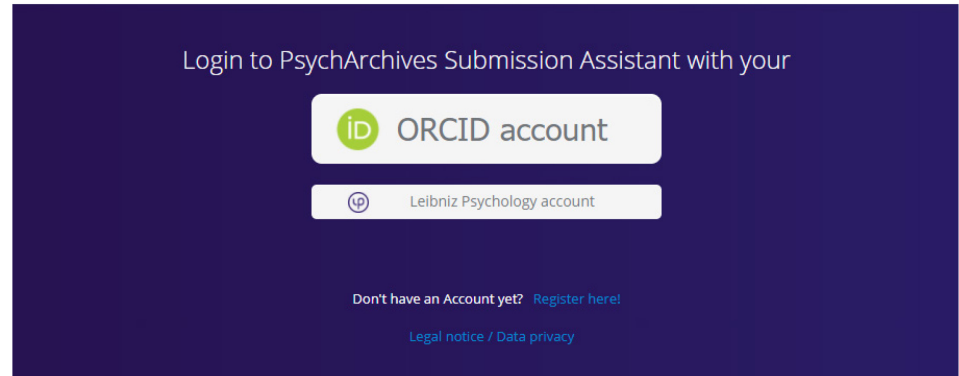

Zusammenfassung und Ausblick

Vorteile der Nutzung:

- niedrigschwellig, schnell, kostenfrei
- Sichtbar- und Zitierbarmachung von Inhalten
- Sicherung der elektronischen Langzeitverfügbarkeit und Langzeitarchivierung
- Open Access-Mandaten von Förderorganisationen sowie Open Access-Policies von Institutionen gerecht werden
- gute wissenschaftliche Praxis → DFG-Leitlinien etc.

- *Sharing Level 0 und 0+ (Public Use File)*
 - offener und unmittelbarer Zugang
 - Nutzung von *Open Content*-Lizenzen
- *Sharing Level 1 (Scientific Use File)*
 - Inhalte werden ausschließlich für die wissenschaftliche Nutzung bereitgestellt
 - standardisierte Lizenzvereinbarung, die von PsychArchives zur Verfügung gestellt wird
- *Sharing Levels 2 und 3*
 - restriktivere Levels
